

DANIEL ALLEN, PIONEER TANNER
(9 Dec 1804-15 Jan 1892)

FAMILY SUMMARY¹

Daniel Allen Jr.,² was born 9 Dec 1804 Whitestown, Oneida, New York, son of Dr. Daniel Allen and Nancy (Agnes) Stewart.³ He was a tanner and shoemaker, tanned the first leather in Utah, and established tanneries in Sanpete, Utah, and Iron counties. He was a veteran of the Utah Black Hawk Indian War. Daniel died 15 Jan 1892 Escalante, Garfield, Utah, and was buried 17 Jan 1892 Escalante Cemetery.⁴

Daniel married (1) **Mary Ann Morris** 5 Oct 1831 in Montville, Geauga, Ohio.⁵ **Mary Ann** was born 11 Jun 1813 Hamburg, Niagara, New York, daughter of Baldwin Morris and Eleanor Richardson.⁶ She died in late April or early May 1846 and was buried in an unmarked grave at the head of Soap Creek beside the Old Iowa Mormon Trail, (Iowa Highway 5) near present-day Moravia, Appanoose Co., Iowa.⁷

They had the following children:

- i. **LeRoy Allen** was born 28 Mar 1833 Montville, Geauga, Ohio, and died probably in 1842 in Nauvoo, Hancock, Illinois.⁸
- ii **Alma Allen** was born 17 Dec 1835 (or 12 Jan 1836) in Montville, Geauga, Ohio, and died 14 Jul 1850 Big Cottonwood, Salt Lake, Utah, and was buried in Salt Lake City, Salt Lake, Utah.⁹

- iii **Mary Ann Allen** was born 10 Mar 1837 Kirtland, Geauga, Ohio. She died 9 Jan 1929 Ferron, Emery, Utah, and was buried 13 Jan 1929 Manti, Sanpete, Utah.¹⁰ Mary married **John Lowry Jr.** 13 Mar 1857 Salt Lake City, Salt Lake, Utah.¹¹ John was born 31 Jan 1829 Palmyra, Marion, Missouri, son of John Lowry and Mary Wilcox. He died 7 Nov 1915 Salt Lake City, Salt Lake, Utah, and was buried in Manti, Sanpete, Utah.¹²
- iv **Diantha Allen** was born 19 Dec 1839 Lima, Hancock, Illinois. She died 20 Jun 1873 Kanarra, Iron, Utah, and was buried 23 Jun 1873 Kanarra.¹³ Diantha married (1) **Alfred Higgins** 26 Feb 1856 Salt Lake City, Salt Lake, Utah¹⁴. Alfred was born 27 Jul 1831 Florence, Huron, Ohio, son of Nelson Higgins and Sarah Blackman. Alf was a notorious rustler and fugitive. He died in abt June 1862 (in Provo Canyon, Utah, Utah, buried in Provo, Utah, Utah), shot near Bear Lake and buried by a Utah posse in Bear Lake, Utah under warrant of Sheriff Orrin Porter Rockwell.¹⁵ Diantha had

three sons. Diantha married (2) **William Shanks Berry**, son of Jesse Woods Berry and Armelia (Milly) Shanks, brother of Louisa Jane Berry Allen, 15 Oct 1862 Salt Lake City, Salt Lake, Utah.¹⁶ William was born 3 Feb 1838 Dresden, Weakley, Tennessee. He died 10 Aug 1884 Cane Creek, Lewis, Tennessee, shot with his missionary companion when attacked by mob and was buried 28 Aug 1884 Kanarra, Iron, Utah.¹⁷

- v. **Eliza Ann Allen** was born 5 Jul 1842 Nauvoo, Hancock, Illinois. She died 20 Jan 1875 Provo, Utah, Utah, and was buried in Provo.¹⁸ Eliza married **George Baum** 7 Mar 1863 Salt Lake, Salt Lake, Utah.¹⁹ George was born 2 Nov 1829 Brandywine, Chester, Pennsylvania, son of John Christian Baum and Hannah Christman. He died 16 Jul 1916 Provo, Utah, Utah, and was buried 20 Jul 1916 Provo.²⁰
- vi. **Daniel III Allen** was born 20 Feb 1846 Nauvoo, Hancock, Illinois. He died in Aug 1846 in Iowa, probably at Mt. Pisgah and is probably buried

Daniel married (2) **Louisa Jane Berry**, daughter of Jesse Woods Berry and Armelia (Milly) Shanks, 22 Jun 1847 in Winter Quarters, Nebraska.²² Louisa was born 1 Dec 1828 Lebanon, Wilson, Tennessee. She died 26 Jul 1902 Teasdale, Wayne, Utah, and was buried 30 Jul 1902 Escalante, Garfield, Utah.²³

vii. **John Albert Allen** was born 16 May 1848 in Kanesville, Iowa. He died 30 May 1848 Kanesville, Iowa.²⁴

Salt Lake, Utah (divorced).²⁶ Zetland was born 15 Feb 1849 on the Atlantic Ocean, son of William Cook Mitchell and Mary Moore.²⁷ He died 2 Aug 1937 Escalante, Garfield, Utah, and was buried 29 Aug 1937 Escalante. Cynthia married (2) **John Rodgers** (married before 1887, divorced before 1898), son of Theodore Rogers and Hannah Jones. John was born 26 Aug 1854 Fillmore, Millard, Utah, died 23 Jan 1932, Fillmore, and was buried in Fillmore.²⁸

He died 11 Jan 1928 Teasdale, Wayne, Utah, and was buried 13 Jan 1928 Teasdale.²⁹ He was Justice of Peace and postmaster in Teasdale. Orson married **Lydia Catherine Adams**, daughter of David Barclay Adams, and Lydia Catherine Mann, 29 May 1878 St. George, Washington, Utah.³⁰

Lydia was born 11 Apr 1861 Beaver, Beaver, Utah. She died 17 Feb 1911 Teasdale, Wayne, Utah and was buried 19 Feb 1911 Teasdale.³¹

- x. **Robert Preston Allen** was born 5 Mar 1853 Salt Lake City, Salt Lake, Utah. He died 5 May 1906 Lewisville, Jefferson, Idaho, and was buried 7 May 1906 Lewisville.³² Robert married **Elizabeth Mitchell** 19 Mar 1874 Parowan, Iron, Utah³³. Elizabeth was born 20 Jan 1857 Parowan, Iron, Utah, daughter of William Cook Mitchell and Mary Moore. She died 17 Mar 1931 Rexburg, Madison, Idaho, and was buried 21 Mar 1931 Lewisville, Fremont, Idaho.³⁴

Washington, Utah.³⁶ Edward was born 31 Jan 1852 Worsbrough, Yorkshire, England, son of William Wilcock, and Elizabeth Sharp. He died 18 Oct 1933 Escalante, Garfield, Utah, and was buried 19 Oct 1933 Escalante.³⁷ He reportedly dictated his biography of Daniel Allen on his deathbed in 1933.³⁸

xii. **Thurza Armelia Allen** was born 5 Jan 1858 Provo, Utah, Utah. She died 10 Feb 1938 Green River, Emery, Utah, and was buried 14 Feb 1938 Teasdale, Wayne, Utah.³⁹ Thurza married **Gilbert Mann Adams**, son of David Barclay Adams and Lydia Catherine Mann, 5 May 1878 Parowan, Iron, Utah.⁴⁰ Gilbert was born 27 Oct 1852 Meadow Creek, Millard, Utah. He died 16 Jun 1921 Hanksville, Wayne, Utah, and was buried 18 Jun 1921 Teasdale, Wayne, Utah.⁴¹
